Directions for travelling by car from Perth

A Sunshine Farmstay is at 524 Meanwood Road, approximately halfway between Denmark and Albany.

If you are travelling via Albany Highway and don't need to go into town, about 1 km past Albany Airport turn right at the second road on the right, which is Link Road (signposted to the trotting track). Going this way will cut about 10 minutes off your trip.

Follow Link Road to the end and turn right onto South Coast Highway, heading for Denmark.

(Otherwise, if you need to go to town, once finished head back out Albany Highway the way you came. When you reach the huge roundabout, go straight across (keeping to Albany Highway) and then turn immediately left after leaving the roundabout. You will then be on South Coast Highway, heading for Denmark.

Travel till you see the green highway marker which says 25km to Denmark. Soon after this turn left into Thomas Road, where there is a "Sunshine" sign. Follow Thomas Road for 4.5 km, then turn right into Meanwood Road. This is the first cross road on Thomas Road and has letter boxes and our sign on the corner. Go about 700 metres up quite a steep hill and on the rise you will see the number 524 and a big red and yellow "Sunshine" sign.

For Jajelup Cottage, continue on along Thomas Road past Meanwood Road and take the next right into Rosedale Road. Jajelup Cottage is 1.3 km along on the right.

If you need a break, Kojonup is a good place to stop on the way through – it's roughly half way and at the bottom end of town is a park, toilets, etc.
